Registration Requirements:

- Payment must accompany registration.
- All attendees must be registered **no later than one week prior** to the class date. **Anyone registering later than this will be charged a \$40 late fee.** We cannot guarantee seats for those who have not pre-registered. There is a **\$50 charge for anyone registering at the door the day of the class.** We're sorry, no exceptions can be made.
- All information on the registration form must be completed.
- **Credit card registrations** may be made online through Acteva (click through the AIA East Bay website) or WALKED IN to the AIA East Bay office. We cannot accept credit card payments via email, mail or phone.
- **Registrations paid by check** can be mailed or walked-in to: AIA East Bay, 1405 Clay Street, Oakland, CA 94612. Payments made by check must be received in the Chapter Office two weeks prior to scheduled class meeting. Payments received after the cut-off date will be returned.
- **Faxed registrations** will not be accepted.

Refund Information:

- 80% refund given if cancelled more than two weeks prior to class.
- 40% refund given if cancelled more than seven days prior to class.
- No refund given if cancelled seven days or less prior to class.
